Available for \$20 at every McMenamins starting Nov. 5, 2013, the Passport rewards frequent visitors (self-declared "cosmic tripsters"), and encourages people to explore beyond their usual locales.

Once the Passport is fully stamped, it can be redeemed for all of the following Grand Prizes:

- Three nights stays at three of our hotels.
- A pair of concert tickets for the Crystal Ballroom or Edgefield Concerts on the Lawn.
- Drinks at happy hour prices Sunday-Thursday for the first year after completing the passport.

Just in time for the holidays, a McMenamins Passport Gift Pack that includes the Passport and a \$20 gift certificate will be available at all locations for only \$35 (\$40 value) between Nov. 5, 2013, and Jan. 1, 2014.
